Acts 19:1-2 (NIV) While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples ² and asked them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” They answered, “No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.”

3 Baptisms

1. _____ – baptized into the body of Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:13 (NKJV) by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body.

2. _____ baptism.

Acts 2:41 (NIV) ⁴¹ Those who accepted his message were baptized...

Matthew 10:32-33 (NIV) ³² “Whoever acknowledges me before others, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. ³³ But whoever disowns me before others, I will disown before my Father in heaven.

3. Baptism _____.

Mark 1:7-8 (NIV) After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. ⁸ I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”

Acts 8:5, 12, 14-17 (NIV) ⁵ Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Messiah there. ¹² ...when they believed Philip as he proclaimed the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. ¹⁴ When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to Samaria. ¹⁵ When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, ¹⁶ because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ¹⁷ Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Luke 4:18 (NIV) ¹⁸ “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to...

Acts 1:8 (NIV) ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

1. _____ all barriers.

Acts 2:38-39 (NIV) Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.”

2. Ask for the Holy Spirit _____.

Luke 11:13 (NIV) ¹³ If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”

3. Be filled _____.

Ephesians 5:18 (NIV) ¹⁸ Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

Acts 13:52 (NASB) ⁵² And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

4. Go _____.

Ezekiel 47:3-5 (NIV) ³ As the man went eastward with a measuring line in his hand, he measured off a thousand cubits and then led me through water that was ankle-deep. ⁴ He measured off another thousand cubits and led me through water that was knee-deep. He measured off another thousand and led me through water that was up to the waist. ⁵ He measured off another thousand, but now it was a river that I could not cross, because the water had risen and was deep enough to swim in—a river that no one could cross.

Ezekiel 47:8-9 (NIV) ⁸ He said to me, “This water flows toward the eastern region and goes down into the Arabah, ⁹ where it enters the Dead Sea. When it empties into the sea, the salty water there becomes fresh. ⁹ Swarms of living creatures will live wherever the river flows. There will be large numbers of fish, because this water flows there and makes the salt water fresh; so where the river flows everything will live.

John 7:37-39 (NIV) “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. ³⁸ Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.” ³⁹ By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.
