1 Corinthians 12:7-11 (NKJV) <sup>7</sup> But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: <sup>8</sup> for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, <sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, <sup>10</sup> to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. <sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

#### ○ \_\_\_\_\_ gifts

- Word of knowledge – To know something specific without having learned it by natural means.
- Word of wisdom – Divine answer or solution for a particular event.
- Discerning of spirits – To be made aware of the presence of a demonic spirit.

#### ○ \_\_\_\_\_ gifts

- Prophecy – A message of encouragement from God through a person.
- Tongues – A message from God in a language unknown to the person the message is given through.
- Interpretation of tongues - Understanding and expressing the thought or the intent of the message in tongues.

#### ○ \_\_\_\_\_ gifts

- Special Faith – A supernatural impartation of belief and confidence for a specific situation.
- Gifts of Healings – Supernatural endowments of divine health.
- Working of miracles – Divine intervention that alters our natural circumstances.

## What do we do?

### 1. Do not \_\_\_\_\_ the Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-22 (NIV) <sup>19</sup> Do not quench the Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Do not treat prophecies with contempt <sup>21</sup> but test them all; hold on to what is good, <sup>22</sup> reject every kind of evil.

### 2. \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ the gifts God has given me.

2 Timothy 1:6 (NKJV) I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you...

Romans 12:3-6 (NIV) <sup>3</sup> For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. <sup>4</sup> For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. <sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us.

### 3. \_\_\_\_\_ the gifts God has given me.

1 Peter 4:10-11 (NIV) <sup>10</sup> Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. <sup>11</sup> If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.

1 Corinthians 14:26 (NLT) <sup>26</sup> Well, my brothers and sisters, let's summarize. When you meet together, one will sing, another will teach, another will tell some special revelation God has given, one will speak in tongues, and another will interpret what is said. But everything that is done must strengthen all of you.

Ephesians 4:11-12 (NKJV) <sup>11</sup> And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.
